

Individual membership requirements

The following categories of membership are available:

1. Full Member

Full membership offers all benefits and voting rights. *Applicants should either:*

- be aged over 21 years
- show a professional interest or experience in the field of underwater technology
- be a graduate of a recognised university or hold a diploma from a recognised engineering institution or a qualification of comparable status in a relevant branch of science or technology

or:

- have held a post of responsibility in the field of underwater technology for not less than three years

**Full Members based in countries where there is no SUT branch are entitled to a reduced subscription fee in recognition of the lower level of membership benefits available, i.e. lack of local meetings.*

2. Associate Member

Associate membership offers all benefits except voting rights and receipt of the *Annual Report, Yearbook* and *Diary*. (The maximum period of time a member may remain in the associate membership category is three years, after which they are eligible for transfer to full membership.) *Applicants should:*

- be able to show an active interest in the field of underwater technology or in a field of engineering, industry, science, teaching or research connected directly or indirectly with underwater technology

3. Student Member

Student membership offers the same benefits as associate membership at a special rate. *Applicants should:*

- be aged over 17 years
- be intending to be engaged in the field of underwater technology or in a field of engineering, industry, science or teaching connected directly or indirectly with underwater technology

Retired members

Applicants who are fully retired and aged over 65 receive a 50% discount on all membership rates.

Half-year subscription

Our membership year begins on 1 July. Applications made after 1 January cover only the remaining half year and therefore the subscription payment should be half the full annual amount.

MEST Federation – 10% discount

Individuals who are or become members of both the SUT and the IMarEST have the opportunity to join the Marine Engineering, Science and Technology (MEST) Federation. Federate Members pay a one-off joining fee and receive 10% discount on their annual SUT and IMarEST membership fees.
